Competition Method	Individual scoring
Competition Date	9 November 2024, 13:00 Hong Kong (GMT+8)
Entry Deadline	1 November 2024, Entry is limited and available on a first come, first served basis. The organizer reserves the right of final determination.
Video upload period	From 5 November 2024, 09:00 Hong Kong (GMT+8) to 7 November 2024, 09:00 Hong Kong (GMT+8)
Online platform	 The Organizer will provide a competition mobile App which should be installed by participants on their personal mobile phones or tablets. Participants should use the App to take Taolu video according to the App instruction on the specified video upload period. Participants have 2 chances of video shooting from which the latest one will be used. Any edited video will be disqualified, and the referees will score on the competition date.
	• It is recommended that participants should enter the test function in advance to test the shooting location and distance.
	 Participants shall choose to perform the Taolu in a well-lit and safe indoor or outdoor environment. The background must be clear and free of debris and avoid glare. Please note the social distancing and epidemic prevention regulations of the area.
	 The camera must be in horizontal position and remain in same position during the performance (not permitted to zoom in and out or up and down). It can only pan left or right at a fixed position by 45° horizontally.
	 It should have enough distance to cover the whole body during the performance. When any part of the contestant's body is outside the video frame, points will be deducted on each movement.

Contestants Qualifications	Open to all lineage of Grandmaster Ip Man for Senior (age 18 or above) and Junior (age 12-17)
Award	Online Certificates: 1st place; 2nd place; 3rd place and Certificate of Participation

	 Junior (regardless of gender): Age between 12 to 17 (year of birth 2007-2012) Male and Female: Age 18 or above (year of birth 2006 or before) J division: 2 participants of any gender, no award but certificate granting. Match of all categories shall be completed between 1 minute 30 seconds to 3 minutes. Each participant should not take more than 2 categories.
Scoring guidelines	 For "Siu Lim Tau" and "Chum Kiu", participants should follow the demonstrations made by Grand Master Ip Man For "Biu Gee", participants should follow the demonstration made by Sifu Ip Ching. Demonstration videos can be found on VTAA website http://www.vingtsun.org.hk Chi Sau: Gor Sau presentation. Both contestants present with their bare hands, presenting their Ving Tsun offensive and defensive skills in a series of movements. The presentation should have logical and effective movements with stability and be enjoyable.
Scoring criteria	Total 10 points, including the following:
0.1001.0	 Shape: 2 points Hand shape, body shape, stance shape, etc. Perform offensive and defensive movement as explained in the Scoring Guidelines.
	 Strength and control: 3 points Mind, Chi, Spirit, Strength, internal and external co-ordination. Mind and spirit combine with breathing control physical movements and performance.
	Skill: 2 points - Hands & Footwork Techniques – correctly express the motion trajectory in line with the specifications of action and use the correct method.
	Overall presentation: 3 points The whole presentation should be consistent with the style of Ip Man lineage: Requirements of Forms, strict structure, reasonable arrangement, outstanding style, tight coordination of offensive and defensive actions.
Referee	VTAA recognized referee
Apparel	Participants must wear neat sportswear. If indecent or inappropriate clothing is found, points may be deducted or disqualified.
Protest	There is no protest allowed for this competition, and the organizer reserves the right to make the final decision on the result of the competition.
